

Here are a few numbers that demonstrate how we do that . . .



A Truly Beautiful Thank You

St. Francis of Assisi Parish in Hamilton just seems to do things right. With the help of a couple of estate gifts and outstanding leadership, they have built a solid financial future for their parish using annuities and endowments.



So what's an annuity? It's a "planned" gift. It's an investment that is great for retirement (the reason the parish gave it to Fr. Connor) *AND* a gift for a parish or ministerial endowment in the future. In this instance, the annuity provides a little extra money for retirement for Fr. Connor, then, when he passes, the remainder goes to the St. Francis of Assisi Parish endowment at the Foundation, which pays quarterly distributions to the parish each year.

When an individual person or couple buys an annuity through the Foundation, they can receive a 40% Montana tax credit as well, courtesy of the Montana Endowment Tax Credit. Annuities from the Foundation start at \$2,500. Each household is eligible for up to \$10,000 Montana tax credit per spouse (\$20,000 total). If you gift stock with signifcan gains, it could produce even more savings.

This gift to Fr. Connor shows the love his parish has for him. The Foundation was honored to help provide the annuity that created this beautiful thank you.
