
Pro-Life Corner Calling all pro-life high school students!

- Must have received Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation
- Must be a full time student with a GPA of 2.8 or better
- Must write an essay stating why you would like the scholarship
- The student will make a listing of their community involvements
- The forms will be signed by a priest where the student is actively attending Mass
- The award will be used for tuition and/or books.

Christmas Wreaths


The 4th Degree Knights of Columbus are taking orders for Christmas wreaths.
