Many thanks to everyone who gave so generously to the recent collection. We gave over 119 lbs. of food to Headwaters Area Food Bank for their Christmas baskets.


Registration for Legendary Lodge camps open in January and fill up fast. Call Rita Vander Vos regarding financial support.
