

A basket will be available in the entryway through Dec. 18th to collect items for the needy, including paper goods, laundry supplies and non-perishable food.


Registration for Legendary Lodge camps open in January and fill up fast. Call Rita Vander Vos regarding financial support.






#### Diocese of Helena Annual Catholic Appeal 2022


We all love the Lord and want to support his work in our parishes and diocese. Annuities are a way
