A basket will be available in the entryway through Dec. 18th to collect items for the needy, including paper goods, laundry supplies and non-perishable food.

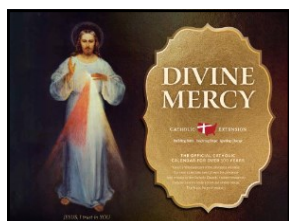
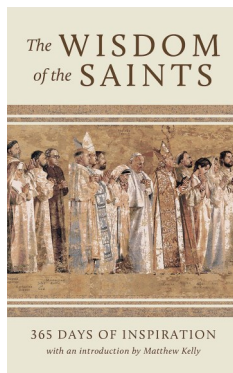
Registration for Legendary Lodge camps open in January and fill up fast. Call Rita Vander Vos regarding financial support.

This year's Advent gift book from the parish, *'The Wisdom of the Saints,'* is available in the entryway. Feel free to take as many as you like...give them as gifts!

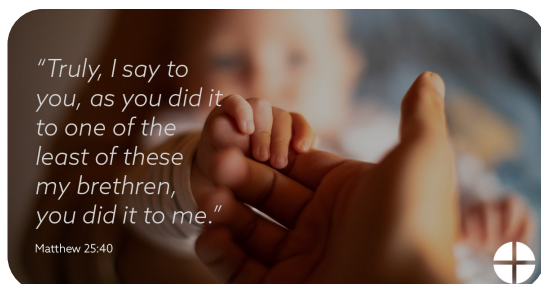

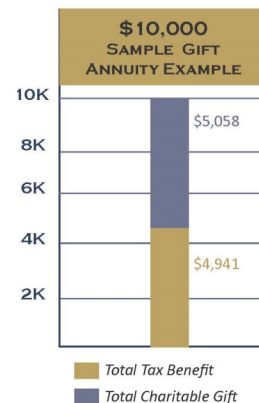
Montana is a unique state, committed to giving back to its nonprofits through the Montana Endowment Tax Credit. This piece of our tax code allows you to give to an endowment through a planned gift (charitable annuity), and then be able to claim a tax credit of 40% of the total charitable gift.
