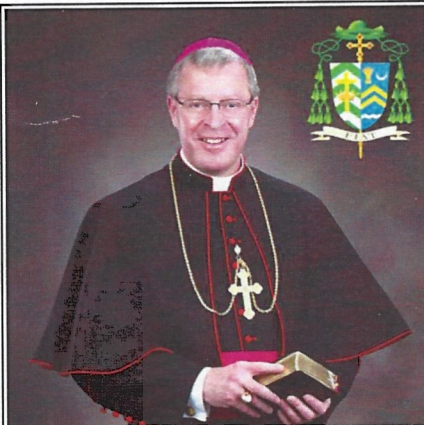
There will be no daily Masses

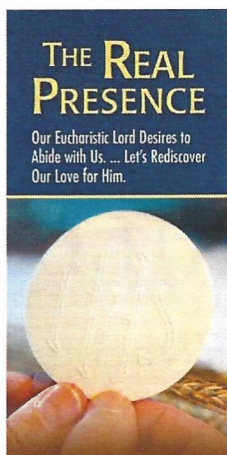

- The award will be used for tuition and/or books.

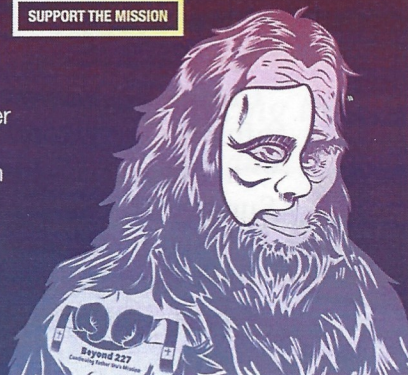
