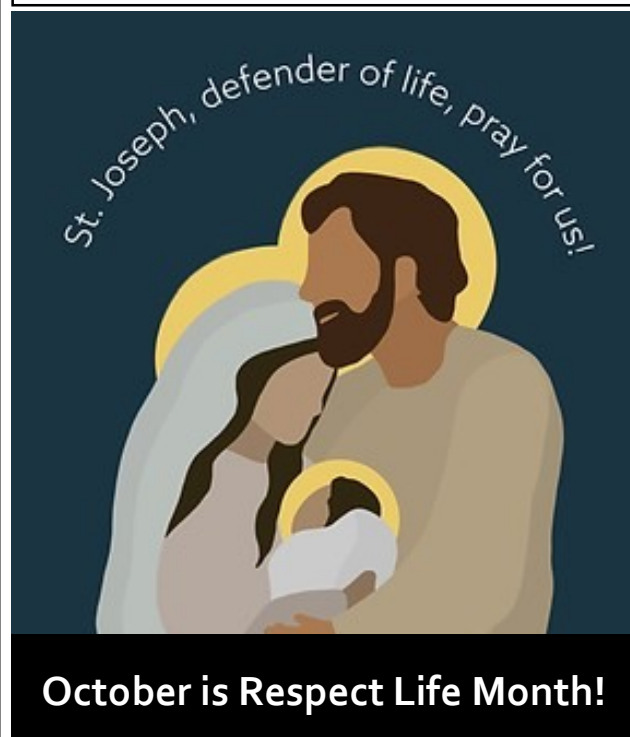

**Do you have anyone in your family interested in 4-H?**

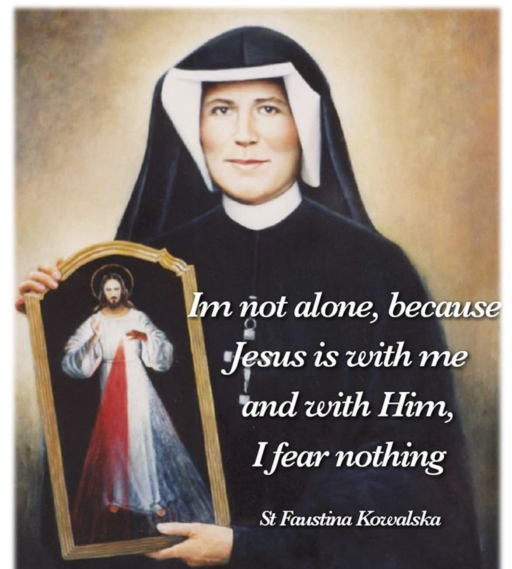

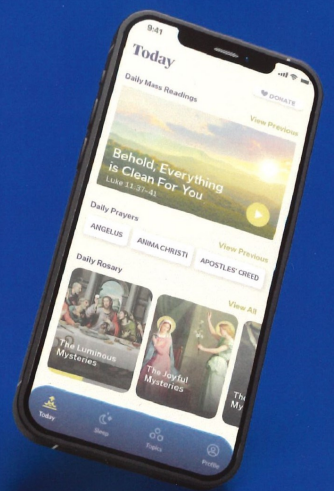
